Qualifications and Insurance

- There is no minimum level of qualification at this time. You must however be able to gain public liability insurance.

Experience and Training

To be able to work as a Corporate Therapist you must go through our inhouse training program and there is a cost attached to this process. We charge this because most therapists have had very limited training in how to do effective chair massage. There is a vast difference between adapting a few massage techniques to the chair and providing an excellent chair massage.

How much is the training?
